

CSS MIN HEIGHT PROPERTY

- ◆ The **min-height** property defines the maximum height of an html element like <h1>, <h2>, <p> tag etc.
- ◆ The estimation of the min-height property can be a number, a length, or a rate.

Example:

- 1 The **Min-height** property specifies the minimum length of a paragraph text, to prevent maximum height property overlapping height property. Here we have specified max-height property as 100px for paragraph tag.

- 2** **Background-color** property in css is used to display a background color for an html element. Over here we have given **background color** property value as yellow for <p> element.

- 1** Here the text “**Welcome to Wikitechy. Best E-Learning Website in the world**” appears with a minimum height of 100pixels and background color yellow appears for 100pixels as displayed in the browser window.
