



CSS MIN HEIGHT PROPERTY

- ◆ The min-height property defines the maximum height of an html element like <h1>, <h2>, tag etc.
- ◆ The estimation of the min-height property can be a number, a length, or a rate.

The **Min-height** property specifies the minimum length of a paragraph text, to prevent maximum height property overlapping height property. Here we have specified maxheight property as 100px for paragraph tag.
