

CSS-Background Image

☞ In CSS, the **background-image** property is being used to set the background image for the body.

Sample Code:

- 1** The background-image property specifies an image to use as the background for the element. URL specifies the location path of the background image.
- 2** Here we have **"This is wikitechy logo!"** which have been called inside the body tag (<body> </body>).

Output:



- 1 The text “**This is wikitechy logo!**” was displayed in the browser window as shown.
- 2 Here, the background image wikitechy.com was displayed in the output.

Note: The **wikitechy.com image** appears repeatedly over here in this output which is nothing but the **REPEAT PROPERTY IN CSS** which we will learn in the forthcoming concepts of CSS.
