

CSS-Background-Repeat

☞ In CSS, **Background-repeat** property is used to control the repetition of an image in the background.

Sample Code:




- 1** The **background-image** property specifies an image to use as the background image for the element. URL specifies the location path of the background image.
- 2** By using repeat property in CSS, we can avoid appearing of image several times in the output browser.
- 3** Here we have the text **Welcome to Wikitechy!** which has been called inside the body tag (<body> </body>).

Note: We can also display image to appear several times in X and Y axis using repeat-x and repeat-y respectively in background repeat property.


Output:
