



<address>-TAG IN HTML

- The <address> tag is used to define the contact information for owner of a document or an article.
- Usually the <address> element is shown in italic.
- The address tag supports **Global and Event attributes.**
- Browsers gives the line break before and after the <address> element.
- <address> tag belongs to Flow Content and Palpable Content Category.

Syntax for <address> tag:

<address>Content is here....</address>

Differences between HTML 4.01 and HTML5 for <address>tag:

HTML 4.0.1

• HTML 4 doesn't support article tag. hence <address> tag defines the author or owner contact information of the documents.

HTML5

• HTML 5 supports an article tag.







Sample coding for <address>tag in HTML:

Code Explanation for <address>tag in HTML:

1. <address> element is given for the contact information of the document.







Output for <address>tag in HTML:



1. Contact information of the document is displayed in the output.
